Kindle the flame of Pentecost

It is said that the medieval hymn “Veni Creator Spiritus” is one of the most widely used hymns in the western church, second only to the “Te Deum”. Most English language hymn books include at least one translation of the Latin, and it is well known in other European languages. Over the centuries the hymn with its plainsong melody has inspired many variants.

The Adelaide 2017 Summer School will be an opportunity to rediscover the extensive and wonderful repertoire of music associated with the Day of Pentecost.

The Summer School will be conducted in the churches of North Adelaide and the city, including Wesley Uniting Church Kent Town, Bethlehem Lutheran Church and St Peter’s Anglican Cathedral.

Accommodation will be at Aquinas College, North Adelaide.

Choral rehearsals, worship services, workshops on aspects of church music, and associated performances and social events will be a significant aspect of the week long program.

MALCOLM ARCHER

Director of Chapel Music at Winchester College in England. His previous positions have included Director of Music at Wells Cathedral and St Paul’s Cathedral in London.

He is much in demand as a choir trainer and choral and orchestral conductor around the world. He is also a fine organist and has released a number of CDs, including music by Bach, Messiaen and his own compositions, especially those written for organ and choir. He is also a widely performed and respected composer.

He is a fellow of the Royal School of Church Music.
